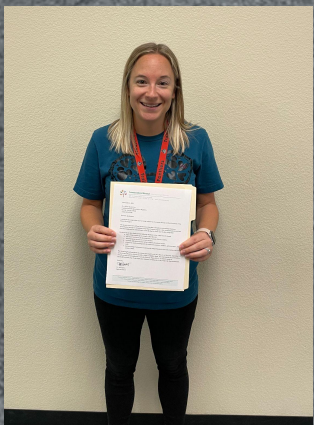


Mr. Gutierrez received the Golden Apple Award for his work in the special education department.

Coming up is red day on September 30th!

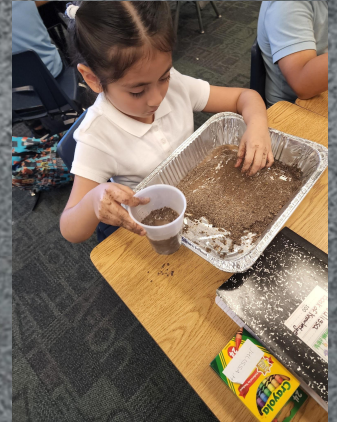

Science



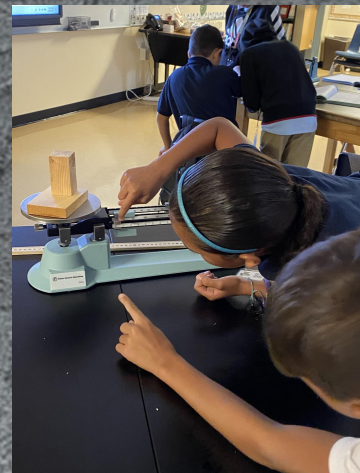
