How many students will be in my child's class?

We will not know what class sizes will be until school starts and students actually arrive. We believe class sizes will be smaller due to the number of families participating in online instruction.

What safety measures are you incorporating?

Will masks be required?

Yes, in accordance with Centers for Disease Control and Maricopa County guidelines, students and staff will be wearing face coverings unless there is a health or religious exemption.



Yes, students will continue to receive special area classes. Art and music will be provided in the classroom. P.E. will be offered outside or in the gym.

Will my child switch classes?

Students will stay in the same classroom for all core subject and special area classes with the exception of P.E. Students who receive special services may be required to transition to receive services.

Will students have recess?

We intend to give students a recess break. A modified schedule will be in place to limit the number of students on the field at one time. Students will also be provided with guidelines about safe play and social distancing that will be reinforced by staff.

Will I be able to volunteer or visit with my child on campus?

Until further notice, parents and other visitors will not be permitted on campus. This is to limit the number of people on campus at a given time.





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Will Kids Club be available?

Yes, before and after school programs will be available.

Will students go on field trips?

Outside field trips are temporarily suspended. Virtual field trips may be an option.

Will clubs and intramural athletics be offered?

After school sports are temporarily suspended. Clubs may be offered depending on how well safety measures can be met.

What if I want to move my child to the distance learning option?

If you are concerned for your child's health you may move them to the distance learning option.

If my child is absent, can they receive online instruction while at home?

No, students will be given work to complete at home as we normally do for absent students, but they will not be able to move to the online instruction option due to a short-term absence.

Can my child bring their own lunch?

Yes.

May I move my child to the distance learning program after the start of school?

Yes, if you are concerned for your child's health, you may move him/her to the distance learning plan after the start of school.
